# **Objective and Purpose of Assignment**

The Water and Sanitation Engineering Division (WSED) of the Ministry of Infrastructure and Sustainable Energy (MISE) has an oversight role for a number of on-going donor-funded water and sanitation-projects. This includes the administration and management during the planning, implementation, operation and maintenance of water and sanitation projects.

The objective of this assignment is to strengthen the project management capacity of the MISE Water and Sanitation Engineering Division.

## **Scope of Work and Duration of Assignment**

Provide day to day guidance and capacity building to the water and sanitation unit to support their role on project management and related engineering aspects for the South Tarawa Water Supply and Sanitation Projects and other related projects under the Water and Sanitation Engineering Division.
